### 14/53 Reports

- i) Mowing the last grass cut was made by Streetscene in October. Early November Streetscene tree experts viewed trees at Whites Meadow and on Hextall Lane. 25 trees in all were identified including young trees which had been produced by the older ones on Hextall Lane. The main requirement is crownlifting of the 25 trees and Streetscene has sent a quote for two days at a cost of £300 plus VAT to include manpower, equipment, time and waste disposal.
- ii) Highways autumn hedge cutting has been poor this year and a complaint has been sent to the County Council which is being looked into.

The patching opposite Virginia Cottage has now been carried out properly. The Neighbourhood Team will be in the parish for 28<sup>th</sup> November only.
